

The conditions of any grant to assist the acquisition of works of art as follows:

- there should be no payment or any contractual agreement with the vendor at the time of the application
- the successful museum will acknowledge the Trust on the museum label and in its documentation
- the work will be kept in suitable premises which adhere to current museum standards of conservation and security
- the work will be accessible to the public during the published opening times of the museum and, if in storage, it should be accessible by appointment
- in the unlikely event of the museum disposing of a grant-aided work of art, the Trust must be informed and immediately after the sale the Trust will be sent the percentage of the selling price that reflects the proportion of the original grant
- the Trust should be informed of any changes of ownership
- the museum must not lend the object to another institution in Britain or abroad for longer than three years
- the Trust should be supplied with a digital photograph (2MB) of the object which it may wish to use, at no cost to the Trust, for its own publicity

The successful applicant will be sent a copy of these conditions for them to sign and to return to the Hon. Secretary. The successful applicant should enclose with the signed form, within three months of notification of a grant offer, a receipted invoice from the vendor together with an invoice from the museum for the agreed amount of the grant. Thereafter a cheque will be sent as soon as possible.
